Re: Republic of Cuba - Guidelines for adoption of extraordinary measures of the seafarer's certificates of competency or certificates of proficiency issued by Cuba Maritime Administration resulting from the COV / D-19 pandemic.

**Excellency,**

In relation to the world situation of the incidence and spread of COVID-19, and what is expressed in Circular Letter No. 4204 / Add 5 and Circular No. 4224, both from the Secretary General of the International Maritime Organization, the Cuban Maritime Administration considers the following guidelines for the adoption of extraordinary measures of certificates of competence of seafarers or certificates of sufficiency issued by the Cuban Maritime Administration:

**Extension of validity of seafarers' documents beyond their expiration date.**

- **Of the Certificates of Competence and Certificates of Proficiency**

The Cuban Maritime Administration has decided that the validity of the Certificates of Competence (CoC) and the Certificates of Proficiency (CaP) of Cuban crew members on board the vessels that which will expire before June 15, 2020 are granted extended validity up to 3 (three) months.


• **Medical certificates.**

Considering this situation ç as a force majeure, with respect to Cuban medical certificates, the Cuban Maritime Administration has decided to follow the provisions for urgent cases allowed by Regulation 1/9 of the STCW Convention 1978 as amended and Regulation 1.2. Of the MLC Convention 2006 amended.

• **Endorsements.**

The seafarer will be granted a temporary endorsement valid for a period of up to 3 (three) months.

The seafarers individually will not be required to submit an application.

Extensión de la validez de los documentos de la gente de mar más allá de su fecha de vencimiento.

- **De los Certificados de Competencia y Certificados de Suficiencia**


La Administración Marítima de Cuba ha decidido que la validez de los Certificados de Competencia (CoC) y los Certificados de Suficiencias (CoP) de los tripulantes cubanos a bordo de los buques que expirarán antes del 15 de junio de 2020 tiene una validez general extendida de hasta 3 (tres) meses.

- **Certificados médicos.**

Teniendo en cuenta esta situación como una fuerza mayor, con respecto a los certificados médicos cubanos, la Administración Marítima de Cuba ha decidido seguir las disposiciones para casos urgentes permitidas por el Reglamento I / 9 del Convenio STCW 1978 enmendado y el Reglamento 1.2. del Convenio MLC 2006 enmendado.

- **Refrendos.**

El marino recibirá un refrendo temporal válido por un período de hasta 3 (tres) meses. No se requerirá que la gente de mar de forma individual presente una solicitud.

The Maritime Transport Affairs Sector of the Ministry of transport & Communications in the State of Qatar, to minimize the risk to the health of seafarers as well as the general public, has decided in this prevailing circumstance and the conditions caused by the spread of the COVID-19, to extend the validity of the previously issued **Endorsements Attesting the Recognition of a certificate** under the provisions of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers, 1978, as amended, for a period of three (3) months from the expiry date that appears on the Endorsement.

To this end, I would like to request the Secretariat of the International Maritime Organization to kindly disseminate the attached information among the member states.

**Subject: Contingency plans to mitigate disruption to delivered services  
in the event of a COVID-19 pandemic**

The Maritime Transport Affairs Sector of the Ministry of Transport & Communications in the State of Qatar, to minimize the risk to the health of seafarers as well as the public, has decided in this prevailing circumstance and the conditions caused by the spread of the COVID-19, the following:

1. The existing **Endorsements Attesting the Recognition of a certificate** under the provisions of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers, 1978, as amended, carried by seafarers working onboard Qatari Flag ships, in case of expiry to be considered valid for a period of three (3) months from the expiry date that appears on the Endorsement.
2. The existing Minimum Safe Manning Certificates, in case of expiry to be considered valid for a period of three (3) months from the expiry date that appears on the certificate itself.
3. Confirmed Receipt of application (CRA) will be issued instead of new Endorsements Attesting the Recognition of a certificate under STCW Convention. by submitting the request application as usual to the email address **Tareq.AlJufairi@motc.gov.qa & Abdallah.Alqahtani@motc.gov.qa**
