- According to the meeting calendar for 2021 (PROG/129/Rev.1), the Secretary-General has the honour to invite representation at the twenty-seventh session of the Technical Group on the Evaluation of Safety and Pollution Hazards of Chemicals (ESPH) of the Sub-Committee on Pollution Prevention and Response (PPR), which will be held remotely from Monday, 11 October 2021, to Friday, 15 October 2021.
