**AMENDMENTS ADOPTED ON 4 NOVEMBER 1993 TO THE INTERNATIONAL
CONVENTION FOR SAFE CONTAINERS, 1972**

Acceptance by Brazil

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to state that the Federative Republic of Brazil has accepted the amendments to the International Convention for Safe Containers (CSC), 1972, adopted in accordance with article IX, paragraph 2(b) of the Convention by the Assembly of the International Maritime Organization, by resolution A.737(18) of 4 November 1993 and transmitted to Contracting Governments for acceptance by Note Verbale A1/N/1.06 (NV.7), dated 24 January 1994.

Acceptance was effected by deposit of an instrument on 6 June 2019.

The 1993 amendments to CSC 1972 adopted by resolution A.737(18) are not yet in force. However, these amendments were incorporated into CSC 1972 as a new set of amendments to the annex to the Convention by resolution MSC.355(92), adopted by the Maritime Safety Committee at its ninety-second session on 21 June 2013. The 2013 amendments, which have the same effect as the 1993 amendments, entered into force on 1 July 2014 under the tacit acceptance procedure and are binding for all States Parties to the Convention.

There are, at present, 12 acceptances of the 1993 amendments to CSC 1972.
