PROTOCOL OF 1997 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FOR THE PREVENTION OF POLLUTION FROM SHIPS, 1973, AS MODIFIED BY THE PROTOCOL OF 1978 RELATING THERETO

Accession by Seychelles

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1997 to amend the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships, 1973, as modified by the Protocol of 1978 relating thereto, and to state that accession by the Republic of Seychelles was effected by deposit of an instrument on 29 November 2019, in accordance with article 5(2) of the Protocol.

The Protocol will enter into force for Seychelles on 29 February 2020, in accordance with article 6(2) of the Protocol.

There are, at present, 96 Contracting States to the Protocol, representing approximately 96.72%* of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.
